Board of Education members recognized this month's SAIL(ORS) On Deck. This month's standout is Bailey Possert, Teacher Assistant at Creekside School, who has exemplified strengths in the organizational value of Service, presented in recognition of responding to the needs of our learning community.

Technology Services Update Presentation – Brandi Reynolds, Director of Technology

Brandi Reynolds presented an overview on the summary of services supported by the technology team who work directly with 10 local districts who we are contracted with providing technology support as well as hosting student information systems such as PowerSchool, project interconnect and firewall services in the region. The REMC 2 staff provide professional learning, and educator assistance in maker materials, 3D printers and book sets. REMC Save Purchasing program saved over \$856,512 this past year that offers discounts with paper, devices, and furniture. Monthly meetings are held with all technology staff throughout the region. Data team members also meet regularly to support our SAIL 2.0 work for state reporting including pupil accounting and newsletter and website resources. Our team members continuously monitor and implement software updates and conduct regular cybersecurity training for staff.

Information Items: Dr. Ceglarek provided board members a summary of the Talent Together Consortium Agreement. Talent Together is the Grow your own program developed by 48 ISDs across the state and we are now up to 50 ISDs. We have 900 soon to be teachers in the pipeline with higher education partners for this cohort. We have another 900 interested for the next cohort. We have a great partnership with Grand Valley State University that Matt Olson has been working on with our own staff for signing up to be special education teachers. We hope to keep Talent Together a model for the state and it speaks volumes that the legislator has committed funding to support this consortium. We are asking for a full commitment from the remaining ISDs by January 1 to join the consortium. We currently have 19 regional employees selected for the first cohort.
