




Students: Teachers and other staff who know me and care about me as a person






Students: At least one adult at my school that I can count on to help and support me if I need assistance






Parents: At least one staff member knows my child well enough to know if something was different or troubling





Staff: Work with people who treat me with respect






Parents: Collaborative relationship between their family and their child's teacher or person that set up the IEP meeting






Staff: Working collaboratively with TBAISD colleagues is valued






Staff: Shared decision making is supported






Local districts: High appreciation for TBAISD collaborating with local schools








Parents: Career-Tech Center staff are responsive to questions and messages






Parents: Communications from TBAISD Special Education Services






Parents: Open exchange of information about their child between their family and TBAISD special education staff






Students: Teachers who give me clear feedback





Staff: TBAISD provides me with tools to communicate effectively






Students: A school environment that feels safe






Students: A school environment safe from bullying






Parents: Discipline consistently enforced at Career-Tech Center






Staff: Appropriate student behavior and discipline are consistently enforced






Parents: Building entrances secure at Career-Tech Center

- Hands-on learning different from the usual school classrooms




Students: What they enjoy most about the Career-Tech Center




Staff: Overall satisfaction as a TBAISD staff member






Parents: Overall satisfaction with TBAISD special education services






Parents: Satisfied with Career-Tech Center






Local districts: Overall satisfaction with TBAISD






Students: Proud to say they're a TBAISD student






Staff: Proud to be a TBAISD staff member
