## **Outstanding Educator Award Criteria**

We encourage schools and communities to nominate individuals who exemplify the qualities of an outstanding educator. To aid in the effectiveness of nomination packets, please take note of the expectations outlined by the Outstanding Educator review team:

- For optimal organization, select one coordinator to manage the nomination process.
- Verify that the nominee has at least five years' experience and has not been a past award recipient.
- Include a letter of nomination by the nominee's supervisor and/or superintendent.
- Gather supporting documents from students, parents, and/or other supporters.

A nomination coordinator can gather as much documented support as desired, but <u>is limited to submitting only 5</u> <u>quality documents for the application process</u>. The review team is dedicated to assessing *all* nomination materials; however, quality is more valuable than quantity which can hinder an equitable review. Please select only letters that best focus on the award criteria below.
