2024 Career Tech Academic Scholarship

The award will be sent directly to the post-secondary institution designated by the student and can be used for tuition or other school expenses.

Students may not apply to both the Career Tech Academic Scholarship and Career Tech Tools of the Trade.

Amount: \$500 each. The top scorer will receive a larger award.

Eligibility:

- Senior (Early College students may apply)
- Attended Career Tech for the full 2023-2024 school year.
- B or higher grade in Career Tech program for first semester 2023-2024.
- Earned full credit for first semester of 2023-2024 school year.

Requirements:

- 1. Complete and print this fillable application.
- 2. Copy of an acceptance letter from a college or technical school.
- 3. Current resume
- 4. Current high school transcript

No handwritten applications will be accepted.

Due: Applications must be <u>delivered to Student</u> <u>Services</u> by 3 pm on March 1, 2024 Late or incomplete applications will not be considered.

Interviews & Presentation: Once the selection committee has reviewed all applications, an interview will be scheduled for qualified applicants.

Please prepare a 5-10 minute presentation based on a skill, project or highlight from your Career Tech program.

You will also answer interview questions.

Professional dress and demeanor are an important part of the interview. Please dress as though you were interviewing for an entry-level position in your field.
