Scholarship Specifics

- There will be a maximum of two recipients awarded.
- Each recipient chosen will be awarded up to \$2,000. The monies will be distributed directly to the recipient's academic institution of choice.
- Scholarship will be awarded at our Career Tech Awards Night.

Eligibility Requirements

- Must be a graduating high school senior.
- Must be completing the second year of a Career Tech two-year program.
- First generation college students are preferred.
- Must have an overall G.P.A. of 2.75 and 3.0 G.P.A. within the respective Career Tech program.
- Must have earned and received full credit for all classes each semester at the Career Tech.
- Must include high school transcript.
- Must have applied to, been accepted to, and be committed to attending an accredited institution of higher learning – vocational institutions included. Letter of acceptance to this institution must accompany application.
- Demonstrated ability to overcome challenges to achieve success.
- Must have a demonstrated financial need.
- Must provide a copy of Federal Student Aid Report page showing your SAI, Student Aid Index.
- Must provide two letters of recommendations that speak to your leadership, work ethic, and academic or work-related skills. One letter must be from a Career Tech Staff Member.
- Finalist must interview before the selection committee.
- Application must be complete.

Deadline for Application:

Application must be postmarked or turned in at the Career Tech Student Services Office by 3:00 p.m. on March 1, 2024.

Faxed or emailed applications will not be accepted.
